MARS Bromont Rising U25 grants are administered by the USEA Foundation. Riders competing in the U25CCI2*-L and U25CCI3*-L are eligible to apply. Up to \$2,500 will be awarded to up to 10 successful applicants to help assist with travel expenses and entry fees for the MARS Bromont CCI, June 5-9 2024.

We've worked hard to put together a full educational component in addition to providing funding for travel, if you do not plan on taking advantage of that please refrain from applying.

- 8. What is the name of your trainer and how many lessons do you take per week or month?
- 9. Please tell us what you think we should know about you in evaluating candidates for the MARS Bromont Rising Program.
- 10. Please discuss why this financial support is important to you.
- 11. What part of the Bromont Rising program do you feel would most benefit you or your horse?
- 12. Attach to the application, a summary of your competition results since October 1, 2023 (of the horse on whom you will be participating in the 2024 MARS Bromont Rising Program). Include all results including penalties, falls, elimination etc.
- 13. Do you agree to participate in at minimum the introductory meeting, centreline workshop, XC prep and XC course walk?
